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The Hungarian Social Report 2019 forms part of the long-standing tradition of social reporting in Europe. Books of this kind in general produce, present and interpret quantitative information on well-being and progress in the society and contribute to better-informed evidence-based policy making. Thirty years after the Hungarian transition started, the 2019 edition (the first in English since 2004) provides a cross section overview of various aspects of the current Hungarian society, and it also presents time series analyses of societal changes in the historic decades of the post-communist Hungary. The book pays particular attention on social structure and mobility, health status, education and housing conditions as well as on attitudes and political preferences. The topics are presented in an international context by comparing data from Hungary and other EU Member States.
